

## **Information leaflet for tourists and guests**

Among us nature-loving campers, it is customary to address each other informally ("duzen"), so we warmly welcome you to our campsite. It is of great importance to us that everyone can have a good, relaxing, and carefree time here. Therefore, it is essential to adhere to the campsite rules, which are posted on the notice board near the cabin. To ensure a smooth stay, we have listed the following key points for you.

### **Upon Arrival**

- Our campsite does not have a reception. Before unloading and setting up your tents, please consult the campsite supervisor at (+41 77 447 16 38) and follow their instructions. We expect you to arrive before 6:00 PM. If you are visiting for the day as a bathing or day guest, please pay the entrance fee at the designated area or to the campsite supervisor.
- No vehicles, including bicycles and scooters, are allowed on the campsite. You can transport your equipment to your spot using a small trailer provided by us.
- **Parking:** When using the parking area, please exercise caution and be considerate of the neighbors' need for peace and quiet. Enter and exit at a slow pace, avoiding unnecessary noise and dust emissions. Respect the municipality's quiet hours, which begin at 10:00 PM. Parking and driving are only allowed forward with a valid parking pass in the designated areas. You can obtain the parking pass from the site caretaker.

### **During Your Stay**

- **Caution!** The lake becomes very deep quickly! Swimming is at your own risk. Never allow children under 10 years old to play by the lake without supervision. The campsite disclaims any liability in case of accidents.
- Behavior and swimwear should not offend moral sensibilities. Parents should not allow children to bathe or play naked and should educate and sensitize them appropriately.
- The entire Greifensee lake is located within a nature reserve! Entering the reed belt on our campsite is strictly prohibited.
- **Boats:** Due to limited space on our site, users of boats cannot leave their boats on the beach. Storing boats in front of, behind, or next to the tents is also not allowed, as a storm could turn these boats into dangerous

projectiles. Therefore, please deflate inflatable boats after use. Users of flotation aids, boats, and surfers must also adhere to existing laws and regulations, such as the Greifensee protection regulations.

- The fixed benches, the fire pit, the playground, the beach volleyball field, and the play equipment are for everyone's use. However, due to limited space, we kindly ask you to respect the privacy of the seasonal campers.
- Making fires is only allowed at the official fire pit. Fireworks are prohibited.
- The warm water in the washrooms is for use only on-site. Please use your gas stove to heat water (e.g., for washing and cooking). Electricity is only allowed for charging smaller devices such as flashlights, laptops, electric razors, e-bikes, etc.
- Dispose of all waste and wastewater in the designated facilities regularly. You can obtain garbage bags from the site caretaker and deposit them in the metal containers located above the campsite (main street).
- Televisions, MP3 players, radios, etc., are only allowed with headphones.
- Dogs and cats are not allowed on the campsite.
- Quiet hours are from 10:30 PM to 7:00 AM from Sunday to Thursday, and from 11:30 PM to 7:00 AM on Friday and Saturday. Please be aware that even the slightest noises can be heard in a tent.

## **Upon Departure**

- Please ensure that your spot is clean and cleared by 11:30 AM on the day of departure. Please take PET and glass bottles to the designated collection points.

We sincerely thank you for your cooperation and hope that your stay at the Nature Lovers' campsite will be a memorable one.
